Conditions of Entry:

- SCA General Rules and Conditions Apply. 60% Payback. Ribbons to 6th Place.
- 8 run limit applies, except for those entered in the encouragement where a 3 run limit applies.
- All riders must be full financial members of the SCA prior to nominating. Full Membership can be completed through the SCA office – sca@campdraft.org.au or online through the members portal – www.campdraft.org.au.
- **Non-members are not permitted to ride a horse on the Bacchus Marsh Campdraft Grounds.**
- Changes to Horse/Rider must be completed no later than one hour prior to an event commencing.
- No refunds for scratchings from 5pm Thursday 19th March.
- Approved helmets must be worn whilst competing (refer SCA Rules “Helmet Requirements”). Anyone under 18 years of age must always wear a helmet while mounted.
- The committee reserves the right to alter the program or refuse entries.
- 60% payback to 6th place.
