



# **SCA Membership Information**

## **SCA Membership Categories and Benefits**

### **Senior Membership**

Senior Membership is available to all riders aged 17 years and over, at a cost of \$165 per year. Membership includes:

- Personal Accident Insurance while competing at any SCA affiliated event
- The SCA quarterly magazine (one copy per family)
- A copy of the Rule Book
- An SCA badge
- Voting rights within the SCA
- Eligibility to compete for Championship Points in SCA and various SCA Zones, as well as end of year awards
- Discount for stallion advertising in the SCA Magazine

To earn Championship Points, horses must be registered with the SCA at no additional cost. Senior members may compete in Encouragement, Rookie, Maiden, Ladies, Novice, and Open categories.

### **Juvenile Membership**

Juvenile Membership is designed for riders aged 13 years and under 17 years, with an annual fee of \$30. Membership benefits include:

- Personal Accident Insurance while competing at SCA affiliated events
- The SCA quarterly magazine (one copy per family)
- A copy of the Rule Book
- An SCA badge
- Eligibility to compete for Championship Points in SCA and various SCA Zones, as well as end of year awards

Juvenile members are eligible to compete in Juvenile, Maiden, Ladies, Novice, and Open events. Horses must be registered with the SCA (at no cost) to earn points.

### **Junior Membership**

Junior Membership is open to riders aged 8 years and under 13 years, at a fee of \$25 per year. Benefits include:

- Personal Accident Insurance during SCA affiliated events
- The SCA quarterly magazine (one copy per family)
- A copy of the Rule Book
- An SCA badge
- Eligibility to compete for Championship Points in SCA and various SCA Zones, as well as end of year awards

Junior members may compete in Junior events. Horses must be registered with the SCA (at no cost) to accumulate points.

### **Mini Membership**

Mini Membership is for riders aged 5 years and under 8 years and is priced at \$20 per year. Members receive:

- Personal Accident Insurance while competing at SCA affiliated events
- The SCA quarterly magazine (one copy per family)
- A copy of the Rule Book
- An SCA badge
- The opportunity to compete in Mini events

### **Non-Riding Membership (Magazine Only)**

Non-Riding Membership is available for \$30 per year and is intended for those who do not ride. Members will receive the SCA quarterly magazine.

### **How to Apply and Renew Membership**

Membership renewals can be completed online through the SCA Members Portal at [www.campdraft.org.au](http://www.campdraft.org.au) New members should visit the designated online form at <https://www.campdraft.org.au/members/new-members/> to complete their application. Weekend memberships will be available from 1st July 2026 and can also be paid online via the SCA Members Portal.

### **Club Fees and Advertising**

- Affiliation Fee to the SCA: \$50
- Public Liability Insurance: \$600

SCA affiliated clubs may advertise in the program at a rate of \$55 for a full page, while half-page advertisements are free. Program advertising is also free on the SCA website, Facebook & Instagram pages. Magazine follow-up articles are provided at no cost. The SCA campdraft run levy is 50 cents (for first round runs); however, this fee is waived for newly formed SCA clubs for their first draft. The SCA Office compiles championship points.

### **SCA Zones**

The SCA does not charge any zone fee or levy. Clubs are free to choose the zone in which they wish to participate. Clubs within each zone determine their own contribution fee toward their zone presentation awards. The SCA supports each zone by contributing \$1,000 toward these awards. The SCA office is responsible for compiling championship points for each zone.

### **SCA Season Dates**

The SCA season runs from 1st July to 30th June each year.
